Enhancement guidelines -Frequently asked questions-

What is an enhancement?

An enhancement is an additional refractive treatment to provide further vision correction.

Why are enhancements needed?

Every eye heals in different ways depending on your body chemistry. Based on your individual response, additional surgery may be necessary to reach your optimal vision correction.

How many patients need an enhancement?

Based on information gathered from Park Nicollet patients only 5% desire enhancements.

How much do enhancements cost?

Park Nicollet Refractive Surgery offers complimentary enhancements for a full 5 years following your initial procedure.

What are the eligibility guidelines?

- Your vision must be at least 1 diopter from the targeted refraction.
- You will need to keep the 1 year follow-up appointment with your surgeon.
- You will need to have documented yearly eye exams.
- Change in vision cannot be caused by a new or unrelated conditions such as (but not limited to) diabetes, cataracts, or age.
- Adjustments to original monovision targeted outcomes are not included.

Your Park Nicollet surgeon will decide if the enhancement is safe and medically appropriate.
